

30 Day Comment Period: Proposed Changes to Clinical/Nursing Division Fee Schedule

The Summit County Health Department is issuing a 30-day formal notice and comment period during which the public can review proposed additions to the Clinical/Nursing Division's fee schedule. These include new fees for rapid lead testing, MMR titers, a combination STI test, and an updated fee structure for the Vaccines for Adults (VFA) program to match the sliding scale used for children.
